It's spring time and the grass contractors have already started mowing. Banks Lawn Care is the grass contractor for all of Northeast Georgia Housing Authority Properties this year.

Some of the responsibilities of the grass contractor include mowing and trimming grass, blowing grass Clippings off sidewalks, deck pads, and porches. They also have the option of using grass/weed herbicide around buildings, a/C pads, clothesline posts, etc.

Please make sure your yard is free of toys, rocks, sticks, paper and other debris. Your cooperation in getting your yard ready for mowing and maintaining your yard is greatly appreciated. By doing this you will prevent Charges to your account.













The maintenance department will pick up large items that will **not** fit inside the dumpster/trash cans at no charge to the resident; the items must be put by the curb. **DO NOT put these items out UNTIL Wednesday after 6pm** of each week. Any items picked up on Monday thru Wednesday could result in everyone in the neighborhood being charged a \$30.00 landfill charge. The truck will be around on Thursday of each week, weather permitting and we are not closed for a holiday or training. If you have loose items, they MUST be tied up in a trash bag.

Bed bugs are on the rise!



If you think you may have bed bugs call The Maintenance Department and refer to your bed bug policy for prevention and treatment.

We have had a mild winter, and the ants will be out in full force in the warmer weather. Remember: We cannot treat the inside of your apartment for fire ants, but we can treat the fire ant mounds in your yard. Below are a few inexpensive home remedies that you may want to try that may be effective in killing fire ants.

- > Salt and Water Bring water to a boil, mix in salt to make a strong salt solution and pour down nest. Repeat over 3 days (and pour over surrounding area as well to prevent them from rebuilding in the area),
- > Instant Grits scrape the top off the mound and pour a package of instant grits directly into the top of the mound.
- ➤ Club Soda pour 2 cups of club soda (carbonated water) directly in the center of the mound. The carbonation in the water is heavier than air and displaces the oxygen which suffocates the queen and the other ants. A one-liter bottle of club soda will kill 2 to 3 mounds.

If you have fire ants inside your apartment, below is a list of spray cleaner recipes

you may want to try...

Clean counter tops and surfaces well with one of the cleaners below, these can also be used to spray the ants directly.

- Vinegar
- Vinegar & Water (50/50 mix)

- Cider Vinegar & Water (50/50 mix)
- One of these essential Oils: Peppermint, Lavender, Eucalyptus, Tea Tree
 Oil, Witch Hazel Extract (1 tablespoon) plus water per spray bottle (these
 oils can also be used to repel spiders)
- Liquid Dish Detergent & Water (about 1 tablespoon detergent) fill spray bottle with water.

Education Scholarship

2-Academic Scholarships for \$2000 each 2-Voc/Tech Scholarships for \$2000 each

Eliqibility requirements:

- 1. Current resident for 12 months or longer; AND
- 2. Have no lease violations; AND
- A high school senior expecting to graduate or have previously earned a high school diploma or GED certificate; AND.
- Have been accepted to or currently enrolled in a college or Technical/Vocational school.

The housing authority reserves the right to adjust amounts of awards based on the number of applications received. This is a one-time award; however recipients may re-apply for consideration in future years.



GED Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Current resident for 12 months or longer.
- 2. 16 years of age or older.
- Enrolled and actively attending GED classes at any of the NGTC Adult Education Centers or certified Literacy Centers.
- 4. Must earn GED in 1 year or less.

Scholarship is open year round.
