What is a School Based Health Center?

A school-based health center is a healthcare clinic based in schools. A provider and staff member from MedLink Georgia will be at the Warrior Wellness Center every school day to provide healthcare services to students and staff members who need it. They provide treatment for injury and sick visits, medication management, mental health, school sports physicals, preventative screenings, vaccinations, and healthcare education.

Must have an appointment!

A one-time payment will be made to the home energy supplier on behalf of eligible households. Eligibility for the program is based on the income of everyone living in the home (please see income chart below for maximum annual income per household size). All eligible households must be responsible for their home heating bill.

Elderly/Homebound Household ONLY: November 1, 2022

*All applicants must be age 65 or older – OR – completely unable to leave the home due to health reasons.
** WATER ONLY – Everyone may apply regardless of age or disability by calling your local office. Local office number can be found on our website at www.ndo.org

- Citizen Verification for the Applicant (photo ID)
- Verification of all household income for the past 30 days
- Most recent home heating AND electric bill
- *Most recent water bill*
