



Southern Biscuit

Bake 425° 15-18 min.



1 cup Buttermilk 2 stick (frozen) unsalted butter 3 cup Self-Rising Flour 1 ½ Teaspoon Salt

½ stick additional butter for pan

In a large bowl add flour, salt, and grated frozen butter into a bowl. Stir to coat butter with the flour. Add ¾ of the buttermilk to mixture. Gently mix with your hands, until the mixture just starts to come together. Roll dough out and cut to desired shape. Place ½ stick butter in a 12-inch cast iron skillet to melt in the oven. Once butter is melted, place biscuits in the iron skillet with sides touching. With a spoon use the melted butter in the pan to coat all sides of the biscuits, then place in oven to bake.

FROM THE DESK OF...

It's about time for the grass cutters to started mowing. Banks Lawn Care is the grass contractor for all of Northeast Georgia Housing Authority Properties this year.



Some of the responsibilities of the grass contractor include mowing and trimming grass, blowing grass clippings off sidewalks, deck pads, and porches. They also have the option of using grass/weed herbicide around buildings, a/c pads, clothesline



posts, etc. Please make sure your yard is free of toys, rocks, sticks,

paper and other debris. Your cooperation in getting your yard ready for mowing and maintaining your yard is greatly appreciated. By doing this you will prevent charges to your account.



The maintenance department will pick up large items that will not fit inside the dumpster/trash cans at no charge to the resident; the items must be put by the curb. DO NOT put these items out UNTIL Wednesday after 6pm of each week. Any items picked up on Monday thru Wednesday could result in everyone in the neighborhood being charged a \$35.00 landfill charge. The truck will be around on Thursday of each

week, weather permitting and we are not closed for a holiday or training. If you have loose items, they MUST be tied up in a trash bag.

Home Care

Residents are expected to properly take care of their home to avoid problems with their lease and poor housekeeping habits that could result in charges for damages.


The stove must be kept clean to avoid fire hazards. The stove tops lift up for convenience in cleaning grease or food spills.

Your refrigerator gaskets around the

door must be wiped clean to avoid sticking and spills must be cleaned to avoid leakages underneath that attract pests.

Reminder: Maintenance cannot treat the inside of your apartment for ants.

Treating Ants/Spiders in your Apartment

If you have ants inside your apartment, below is a list of spray cleaner recipes you may want to try......Clean countertops and surfaces well with one of the cleaners below, these can also be used to spray them directly.

- Vinegar
- Vinegar and water (50/50 mix)
- Cider Vinegar and Water (50/50 mix)
- Liquid Dish Detergent and water (about 1 table spoon detergent, fill spray bottle with water)
- One of these essential oils: peppermint, Lavender, Eucalyptus, Tea Tree Oil, Witch Hazel Extract (1 tablespoon) plus water-per spray bottle (these oils can also be used to repel spiders.)

We can treat the fire ant mounds in your yard. Below are a few inexpensive home remedies that you may want to try that may be effective in killing fire ants.



Salt and Water – Bring water to a boil, mix in salt to make a strong salt solution and pour down nest. Repeat over 3 days (and pour over surrounding area as well to prevent them from rebuilding in the area).

Instant Grits –
scrape the top off
the mound and
pour a package of
instant grits
directly into the
top of the
mound.



Club Soda – pour 2 cups of club soda (carbonated water) directly in the center of the mound. The carbonation in the water is heavier than air and displaces the oxygen which suffocates the queen and the other ants. A one-liter bottle of club soda will kill 2 to 3 mounds.


