FEBRUARY SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: February 20th & April 25th, 2024

1) Gordon A. Rich Memorial Scholarship - \$50,000 - 9 Awards (Deadline: February 20, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a graduating high school senior who plans to enroll as a full time student in pursuit of a four-year bachelor's degree at an accredited college/university in the United States.

B) Have a minimum grade point average of 3.5 (on a 4.0 scale) and rank in the top 20% of their class.

2) Women's Cyber Security Scholarships - \$5,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: February 29, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be pursuing, or plan to pursue, a degree with a focus on cybersecurity or information assurance.

B) Be a senior in high school with a GPA of at least 3.3 on a 4.0 scale.

3) American Chemical Society Scholars Program - \$5,000 - 350 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Intend to major in chemistry, biochemistry, chemical engineering, chemical technology, or another chemistry-related science AND plan to pursue a career in a chemistry-related science.

4) National Italian American Foundation Scholarships - \$12,000 - 200 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled in a US accredited institution of higher education on a full-time basis for the Fall 2024 semester.
- B) Have a GPA of at least 3.5 out of 4.0 (or the equivalent).

5) Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation Scholarships - \$40,000 – 10 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a child or stepchild of one of the following: Active duty, Reserve, or veteran U.S. Marine.
- B) Have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

6) American Welding Society National Scholarships - \$7,000 - 130 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning to pursue a bachelor's or associate degree in welding or a related discipline.
- B) Be enrolled in a US accredited institution for the Fall 2024 semester.

7) WWGF Foundation Scholarships - \$20,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: March 8, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be an active participant in the sport of golf (golf ability is not a criterion for selection).
- B) Have a 3.5 GPA or above on a 4.0 scale.

8) Microsoft Disability Scholarship - \$20,000 – 8 Awards (Deadline: March 13, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a current high school senior living with a disability (as defined by WHO), whether that be visual, hearing, mobility, cognitive, speech or other disability.

9) Joieful Connections Scholarship - \$5,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: March 21, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school senior who will be attending college/university in the Fall of 2024.

B) Have been diagnosed with a developmental or intellectual disability.

10) Kochhar & Co. Chartered Professional Accountant - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: March 31, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

B) Have achieved a GPA of 2.5 or greater during their last academic year.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a graduating senior.

B) Have at least one parent or legal guardian who is an American Federation of Teachers member.

12) Young Women in Public Affairs Award - \$5,000 - 37 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a women, ages 16-19 on April 1, living in a Zonta district/region.
- B) Demonstrate evidence of at least one of the following: Active commitment to volunteerism, experience in local government, student government, or workplace leadership.

13) American Foreign Service Association Scholarship - \$2,500 - 2 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be attending a public, private, or parochial high school.
- B) Be attending school in one of the fifty states, the District of Columbia, or the US territories.

JANUARY SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: January 31st & May 15th, 2024

1) Union Plus Scholarship - \$4,000 - 199 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a current or retired member of a participating union, their spouse or a dependent child.
- B) Have at least one year of continuous union membership by the applicant, applicant's spouse or parent.

2) Melvin Kruger Endowed Scholarship - \$20,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior.
- B) Have a relative that is employed in the roofing industry.

4) Society of Manufacturing Engineers Scholarship - \$20,000 - 60 Awards (Deadline: Feb 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior, current undergraduate or graduate student who will be enrolling as part-time or full-time undergraduate or graduate student in the Fall of 2024.
- B) Have a minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or 70 on a 100 point scale.

5) Davidson Fellows Scholarships - \$50,000 – 20 Awards (Deadline: February 14, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be 18 or younger as of the application deadline.
- B) Have completed a significant piece of work in one of the submission categories.

- B) Plan on attending a Historically Black College or University for the entirety of their college education.

9) Coast Guard Exchange Scholarship Program - \$2,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: February 28, 2024)

- B) Be a dependent of a Coast Guard active duty, reserve, current civilian NAF and APF employees, or current Coast Guard Auxiliarists.

10) Eagle Scout of the Year Scholarship - \$10,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have reached their 15th birthday and be enrolled in high school.
- B) Be a registered active member of a Boy Scouts of America unit that is chartered to an American Legion post, American Legion Auxiliary unit or Sons of The American Legion squadron.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

12) American Nuclear Society Scholarship - \$5,000 – 96 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school senior who has enrolled full-time in college courses pursuing science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) with an interest in working in nuclear science and technology.

B) Have a GPA of 2.5 or greater.
